## THE PROGRAM

This program is 4 weeks in total, with an optional 1 week add-on in the Amazon, Galapagos, or the Andes.

Rio Muchacho Organic Farm & Ecolodge is a National Geographic endorsed social enterprize, a becon of sustainable agriculture, environmental education and alternative tourism. The farm is 20 minutes by car from the beach town of Canoa, in Manabi. The food is deliciously healthy and the climate mild.

This experience is perfect for those who want to discover a new culture and way of living, based on permaculture and agroecology. Half the day is dedicated to cultural activities and you have the choice of volunteering or free time for the rest of the day.

This is also an opportunity to contribute to this important model. Your visit (whether you volunteer or not) helps make this initiative sustainable and supports the continuation of eductional projects for the local and wider community.





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# HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

We have put together a creative program that will take place in the afternoons. In the mornings you can choose to:

1. Volunteer (4 half days / week)

2, Have free time ( for yoga, reading walking, on-line work or Spanish classes etc.

Weekends are free for spending at the gorgeous beach or exploring the area.

Cultural activities take place :13H30-14H30 They are a colorful combination of cooking, crafts, hikes, horse riding, adventure, community visits, sport, and sustainbility related activities.

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## **Our Vision**

In Rio Muchacho we are passionate about agriculture, education and tourism for a better planet, and we live and share this passion. Visitors learn from the moment they set foot on the farm.

We believe in a strong connection with our food, and we work with recovering biodiversity, carbon sequestration, enrichment and regeneration of soil life to produce abundance in crops, which are transformed into delicous healthy food. We then recycle everything through alternative, circular and spiralling economies. Our efforts have returned the wildlife and created a more balanced environment where benefits are felt in the local and wider community. We started the farm in 1990 on barron, dry land. Now it has been transformed into an Organic Farm Park- a recreational learning space for all ages.

For some years we have been working with Ayni, a German based Ethical Tourism Organisation.

(Ayni is a Quechua word meaning the Andean law of reciprocity). We share the same values of assiting communities in creating positive pathways towards sustainable prosperity through ecotourism and agriculture.
